#### AN ACT RELATIVE TO HOMEOWNER INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 99 of Chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is 2 hereby amended after line 349 by adding the following new text:-3 4 Seventeenth. Nothing listed in this section shall prohibit a company from issuing a contract to insure against loss by fire or other perils that excludes coverages for wind based damages. 5 6 7 8 SECTION 2. The Massachusetts Property Insurance Underwriting Association, as established under Chapter 175C 9 of the General Laws, shall be hereby directed to develop and implement a residual market for wind based 10 damages, for applicants who are unable to obtain such coverage in the voluntary market.
