The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR RETIREMENT CREDIT FOR CERTAIN SERVICE .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 32 of the general laws is hereby amended as follows:

2 Amend the definition of “creditable service” by adding after the word “inclusive” the words
3 “...including without being limited to service rendered to a government unit by a consultant or
4 so called 03 employee where such service has been rendered under the direction and control of a
5 governmental unit.”

6 Amend lines 27 and 28 of the definition of “employee” by deleting the words “...and
7 excluding any person whose compensation for service rendered to the commonwealth is derived
8 from the subsidiary account 03 of the appropriation of any department, agency, board or
9 commission of the commonwealth;”

10
