AN ACT RELATIVE TO SALES TAX EXEMPTION FOR DISABLED VETERANS, POLICE OFFICERS, AND FIREFIGHTERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the two following paragraphs:—  
3  
4 (ww) Sales of new and used automobiles purchased by any person who is a disabled veteran.  
5  
6 (xx) Sales of new and used automobiles purchased by any disabled police officer or firemen who  
7 has been injured in the line of duty and as a result of such injury has become disabled.
