AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXPIRATION OF A FIREARM IDENTIFICATION CARD OR GUN LICENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 129B of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words "civil fine of not less than \$500 nor
- 3 more than \$5,000" in lines 224 and 225 and inserting in place thereof the following:- fine of not
- 4 less than \$5,000 nor more than \$10,000 or by imprisonment in a jail for not less than 6 months
- 5 nor more than 1 year or by both such fine and imprisonment.

7 SECTION 2. Section 131 of said chapter 140, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking

- 8 out the words:- "civil fine or not less than \$500 nor more than \$5,000" in lines 308 and 309 and
- 9 inserting in place thereof the following:- fine of not less than \$5,000 nor more than \$10,000 or
 10 by imprisonment in a jail for not less than 6 months nor more than 1 year or by both such fine
- by imprisonment in a jail fand imprisonment.

SECTION 3. Said chapter 140 is herby further amended by inserting after section 131 thefollowing section:-

- Section 131 ¼ . Any application for the renewal of a firearm identification card or a
 license to carry firearms shall be accompanied by a photograph of the said number of the
 weapon, or weapons, covered thereunder.
