AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF CRIMINAL PROSECUTORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting after the word “more” the words:— , assistant attorney general for
- 3 criminal matters which shall include individuals whose primary responsibility is the prosecution
- 4 of criminal matters on behalf of the attorney general, as so certified by the attorney general.
