**AN ACT CREATING ASSIGNMENT LEVELS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EARLY EDUCATION AND CARE.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 10 of Chapter 28A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:-

3           The commissioner shall ensure that no licensor shall have assignment levels of day care centers  
4 or family day care homes in excess of the standards set forth by the National Association for the  
5 Education of Young Children and shall request the same in the Office's budget request to the General  
6 Court. Reasonable assignment levels shall be established for residential and placement licensors and  
7 investigators in order to provide adequate protection and quality care for children in licensed facilities.  
8 The commissioner's annual budget request to the General Court shall include sufficient funding to meet  
9 said assignment levels.
