AN ACT DESIGNATING THE BUILDING OF THE STATE LABORATORY INSTITUTE AS THE WILLIAM A. HINTON LABORATORY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to
2 provide forthwith for the designation of the State Laboratory Institute building as the William A. Hinton
3 Laboratory, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate
4 preservation of the public convenience.

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6 SECTION 1. Chapter 272 of the acts of 1975 is hereby repealed.

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8 SECTION 2. The building of the State Laboratory Institute, located in the Jamaica Plain district of the city
9 of Boston, shall be designated and known as the William A. Hinton Laboratory, in memory of Dr. William
10 A. Hinton, a pioneer in bacteriology and immunology and former head of the department of public
11 health state biologic laboratory. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached to the
12 building by the department of public health.

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
