**AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE DEMOLITION, REMOVAL AND SITE CLEANUP OF
ABANDONED HOUSES AT TEWKSBURY STATE HOSPITAL.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing a certain item in the general appropriation act for
- 2 fiscal year 2010 the sum set forth in section 2 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for
- 3 the purpose and subject to the conditions specified in this act and subject to the laws regulating
- 4 the disbursement of public funds for fiscal year 2010. The sum shall be in addition to any
- 5 amounts previously appropriated and made available for the purpose of this item.

- 6 4590-0195 for the demolition, removal and site clean-up of abandoned houses of the hospital
- 7 located on Livingston Street in the town of Tewksbury.
