### AN ACT PREVENTING INDEMNIFICATION FOR WILLFUL, WANTON, CIVIL RIGHTS VIOLATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 258 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking the words  
2 'shall' in line 1 and inserting the word 'may' in its place.

4           SECTION 2: Section 9 of Chapter 258 of the General Laws is hereby further amended by striking the words "or  
5 omission which constitutes a violation of the civil rights of any person under any federal or state law, if such  
6 employee or official or holder of office under the constitution at the time of such intentional tort or such act or  
7 omission was acting within the scope of his official duties or employment" in the first sentence.

9           SECTION 3: Section 9 of Chapter 258 of the General Laws is hereby further amended by striking the words "other  
10 than a person holding office under the constitution acting within the scope of his official duties or employment" and  
11 the words "any such" in the second sentence.
