AN ACT TO ALLOW A FORMER NATIONAL GUARDSMAN CREDITABLE SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 4 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 2004 Official Edition, the Massachusetts Retirement board is hereby authorized and directed to grant Dennis
3 Otis creditable service for the years of 1964 to 1970, inclusive, during which he served within the Massachusetts
4 National Guard; provided, however, that he shall pay into the annuity savings fund, in one sum or installments, as
5 the board shall determine, an amount equal to the regular deductions which would have been deducted for said
6 period together with regular deductions which would have been deducted for said period together with regular
7 interest thereon. Dennis Otis shall, in addition to his actual membership service, be entitled to credit for the
8 portion of the creditable service which the total of his actual payments, together with regular interest thereon to
9 the date such retirement becomes effective, bears to the total amount of what her payment, together with regular
10 interest thereon, would have been had he made a payment in one sum on the effective date of his retirement.
