AN ACT DIRECTING THE STATE RETIREMENT TO GRANT CREDITABLE SERVICE TO  
DANIEL CONDON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the state  
2 retirement board shall credit Daniel Condon with creditable service for the period of time between the year 1998  
3 and 2002 inclusive, in which he was employed by the Congress of the United States for the purpose of determining  
4 his superannuation retirement allowance pursuant to paragraph (a) of subdivision (2) of section 5 of chapter 32 of  
5 the General Laws. Before the date that any retirement allowance becomes effective in the case of Daniel Condon,  
6 he shall pay into the annuity savings fund of the state retirement system in one sum or installments, upon such  
7 terms and conditions as the board may prescribe, an amount equal to that which would have been withheld as  
8 regular deductions from his regular compensation for such previous service, plus interest.
