## AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN UTILITY REGULATIONS...

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The fifth paragraph of section 69H of chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 2000 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out paragraph (4) and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following 2 subparagraphs:—
- 4 (4) The board shall have the opportunity to issue orders with respect to any matter over which it has
- 5 jurisdiction. Anyone who violates any such order may be subject to a civil penalty not to exceed \$25,000
- 6 for each violation for each day of the violation; but the maximum civil penalty shall not exceed
- 7 \$5,000,000 in the aggregate. In the case of plants under construction, the board shall have the authority
- 8 to revoke all related permits should there be repeated violations. Additionally, the board shall in cases
- 9 for plants under construction, have the authority to deny the opening of such plant should there be
- 10 related violations
- 11 (5) In the event that the board finds a violation, the board shall have the authority to assemble a citizen
- advisory group, consist of 5 persons, 3 of whom to be appointed by the mayor or board of selectman or
- 13 governing body of the municipality in which the energy facility is located, 1 of whom to be appointed by
- 14 the energy company which is the subject of the potential violations, and 1 of whom to be appointed by
- the department of telecommunications and energy. Such board will serve as an advisory authority to
- assist the department of telecommunication and energy and or the energy facilities siting board with

- 17 review of violations, or potential violations, and such board will assist with and make recommendations
- 18 for penalties to the energy facilities siting board and the department of telecommunications and energy.
