## AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PRACTICING VETERINARY MEDICINE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 58 Chapter 112 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended by adding at the end of
- 2 the subsection 3 the following:
- 3 The medical treatment and rehabilitation of wildlife (clientless animals "owned" by the state) by
- 4 licensed 501 c 3 humane organizations conducted under the general supervision and control of an
- 5 animal care and use committee which is comprised of an in-house veterinarian, a staff member, and
- 6 outside veterinarian, and a member of general public appointed by the organizations board of directors
- 7 and approved by the board of veterinary medicine.

- 9 Furthermore section 58 of Chapter 112 in subsection 6 is amended by adding after the word "livestock"
- the following:
- 11 Or wildlife
