## AN ACT RELATIVE TO REAL ESTATE TAX EXEMPTION FOR VETERANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of Chapter 29 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
- 2 Edition is hereby amended by adding the following new paragraph:
- 3 Twenty-second F, notwithstanding the provisions of this section, in any city or town which accepts the
- 4 provisions of this paragraph, said exemptions available under clauses twenty-second, twenty second A,
- 5 twenty second B, twenty second C, twenty second D, and twenty second E, may be granted to otherwise
- 6 eligible persons who have any interest in real property through a trust, either as trustee or beneficiary,
- 7 and provided the real property is his or her domicile.
