AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROTECTING THE RIGHTS OF CUSTODIAL, MAINTENANCE AND
OTHER NONTEACHING EMPLOYEES OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 59B of chapter 71 is hereby amended by adding the following words at the end of the
2 first paragraph: “as used in this section, the words, “other personnel” shall not include custodial maintenance,
3 clerical, and any other similar positions not providing direct educational services to students. In the case of such
4 positions, the hiring, promotion and firing of employees shall be completed in accordance with the provisions of any
5 collective bargaining agreement covering such employees, or, in the absence of a collective bargaining agreement,
6 by the school committee.”
