## AN ACT DESIGNATING A BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF CLINTON AS THE ARTHUR J. MAYOU MEMORIAL BRIDGE .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The bridge spanning routes 70 and 62 in the town of Clinton at Chestnut street over the Nashua
- 2 river, shall be designated and known as the Arthur J. Mayou memorial bridge, in honor of Arthur
- 3 J. Mayou, who served honorably as a member of the rifle squad of the 106<sup>th</sup> division of the Army
- 4 of the United States during World War II, fought in the Battle of the Bulge, and was captured
- 5 and held by the German army as a prisoner of war for 5 months before being liberated in May of
- 6 1945. The department of highways shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing said
- 7 designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
