AN ACT RELATIVE TO FILING FALSE EMERGENCY REPORTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 269 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 13A the
- 2 following section:—
- 3 Section 13B. Whoever intentionally and knowingly makes or causes to be made a false report of any
- 4 emergency situation to the police, or an enhanced 911 service or any other emergency service provider
- 5 shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment in a jail
- 6 or house of correction for not more than one year or both.
