of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws subsection (g) as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition shall
- 2 be amended in Group 4 by adding in line 298 after the words “county correction facilities” the following:-
- 3 Employees of the trial court who hold the position of assistant chief probation officer, probation officer in charge,
- 4 probation officer and associate probation officer or assistant chief court officer court officer I , court officer II .
