AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE VACATION TIME OF A CERTAIN EMPLOYEE OF THE TRIAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, and in order to satisfy a moral obligation, John J.
- 2 McAuliffe, an employee of the trial court of the Commonwealth, shall be entitled to 5 weeks of vacation, annually.
- 3
