**RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE
NOTIFICATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION OF THE RELEASE OF CERTAIN
INMATES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 *Resolved,*

2 That a special commission, to consist of two members of the senate, four members of the house of
3 representatives and three members to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose of
4 making an investigation and study relative to the feasibility of requiring the department of correction to provide
5 notice of the release of any inmate to the appropriate local police departments and any other appropriate persons.
6 Said commission shall report to the House of Representatives the results of its investigation and study and its
7 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation, necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by
8 filing the same with the clerk of the House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in December, two
9 thousand and ten.
