## AN ACT FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF JUDGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION I. Article 1 of Part 2, chapter 3 of the constitution is hereby amended by striking 2
- 2 the words: "that upon attaining seventy years of age said judges shall be retired." and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the words: "that upon attaining seventy-six years of age said
- 4 judges shall be retired."
