AN ACT REGARDING THE ISSUANCE OF A WARRANT WHERE THERE IS AN IMMINENT  
THREAT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 276 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 24, as  
2 appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

4 Section 24. Upon a complaint or indictment for any offense, a summons shall issue  
5 instead of a warrant, unless, in the judgment of the court or justice, there is reason to believe  
6 that the defendant will not appear upon summons or there is an imminent threat of bodily  
7 injury, of the commission of a crime, or of flight from the commonwealth by the person against  
8 whom such complaint is made.
