Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 18 of chapter 240 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in lines 3 and 4, inclusive, the words "supreme
- 3 judicial court" and inserting in place thereof the words: appeals court or, subject to the
- 4 provisions of section ten of chapter two hundred and eleven A, to the full court of the supreme
- 5 judicial court.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 28 of chapter 278 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 7 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 3 the words "supreme judicial court" and
- 8 inserting in place thereof the words: appeals court or, subject to the provisions of section ten of
- 9 chapter two hundred and eleven A, to the full court of the supreme judicial court.
- SECTION 3. Section 28E of chapter 278 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 11 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in lines 9 and 10 the words "supreme judicial court"

- and inserting in place thereof the words: appeals court or, subject to the provisions of section
- ten of chapter two hundred and eleven A, to the full court of the supreme judicial court.
