AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE VENUE OF PROSECUTIONS FOR LARCENY BY CHECK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 277 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after section 62B the following section:-

4 Section 62C. The crime set forth in section 37 of chapter 266 may be prosecuted and  
5 punished in any judicial district where the check, draft or order for the payment of money was  
6 executed or delivered, or where the money or property or services obtained thereby were  
7 delivered.
