**AN ACT TO EXEMPT CERTAIN CRIMINAL MISDEMEANORS FROM THE HEARING  
PROVISIONS OF G.L.C.218, SEC. 35A.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 35A of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

4       This section shall not apply to (1) substitute complaints that are issued to correct a  
5 misstatement or omission of form in an earlier complaint; or (2) complaints for violations of  
6 section 82A of chapter 276; or (3) complaints that are issued after the accused was offered an  
7 opportunity to be heard pursuant to a civil citation procedure authorized by statute in which  
8 the accused was charged with the same conduct as a civil infraction.
