AN ACT RELATIVE TO CREDIT CARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. . Section 12H of chapter 255 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002 Official
2 Edition, by inserting after the word "balance" in line 21 the following, "or \$10.00 whichever is less and
3 the interest rate of a credit card shall not increase due to such delinquency."
