## AN ACT RELEVANT TO RESIDENT PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5c of Chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended to insert after the word “purposes” in the first sentence the words:-
- 3 , and for any secondary residence of a tax payer who resides in the Commonwealth and is not used as a
- 4 rental property for more than two weeks in a calendar year.
