**AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MINIMUM TRAINING WAGE**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Said chapter 151 is hereby amended by adding at the end of the first
- 2         paragraph the following:—
- 3         This Section shall not apply to workers under the age of eighteen during the first ninety (90)
- 4         days of employment. Said ninety day (90) period shall be referred to as a training period. A
- 5         wage of less than \$0.50 below the minimum wage, in any occupation, during a training period
- 6         as defined in this chapter, shall conclusively be presumed to be oppressive and unreasonable,
- 7         wherever the term “minimum training wage” is used in this chapter, unless the commissioner
- 8         has expressly approved or shall expressly approve the establishment and payment of a lesser
- 9         wage under the provisions of sections seven and nine.
