AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE RETIREMENT BENEFITS OF CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS. .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 28M of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following new sentence:-
- 3 Notwithstanding the provisions of sections one to twenty-eight, inclusive, to the contrary, any
- 4 employee of the department of correction, classified under Group 4, whose major responsibilities
- 5 include the care and custody of prisoners, and any transportation officer working within the
- 6 department of correction, who has performed services in the department of correction for not less
- than twenty years, provided, the majority of years of service was performed within one or more
- 8 titles in Group Four, shall, at his own request, be retired by said retirement board.
