AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF WILLIAM FONTAINE AS A POLICE OFFICER IN THE TOWN OF NORTH ATTLEBORO NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to
2 waive the maximum age for the Civil Service exam for appointment to the position of police officer in
3 the town of North Attleboro; therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the
4 immediate preservation of public safety. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
5 the personnel administrator of the human resources division shall certify William Fontaine to be eligible
6 for original appointment to the position of police officer in the town of North Attleboro according to
7 the grade he received on the examination taken on May 19, 2007 for police officer;
8 notwithstanding the maximum age requirement for the position. If William Fontaine
9 meets all other requirements for certification as a police officer, the town of North
10 Attleboro may appoint him.
