AN ACT PROVIDING FOR RESTRAINING ORDERS FOR VICTIMS OF A CRIME AND THEIR FAMILY MEMBERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 209A of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after Section C the
- 2 following section:—
- 3 Section 3D. For the purposes of this section, a "victim" shall be a person who suffers personal injury or
- 4 death as the result of a crime. A "family member of a victim" shall include the spouse, parent,
- 5 grandparent, stepmother, stepfather, child, grandchild, brother, sister, half-brother, half-sister, adopted
- 6 children of parent or spouse's parents. An "offender" shall be a person who commits a crime against a
- 7 victim.
- 8 A victim or family member of a victim may file a complaint in the court requesting an order permanently
- 9 restraining an offender from any contact with the victim or family member of a victim. Said proceedings
- shall be governed by the applicable provisions of section three except the relief shall be a permanent
- 11 restraining order.
