## AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR TANYA M. DUBOIS, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE TRIAL COURT.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation for this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is forthwith to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the trial court, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the trial court shall
- 2 establish a sick leave bank for Tanya M. Dubois, an employee of the court. Any employee of the court may
- 3 voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Tanya M. Dubois.
- 4 Whenever Tanya M. Dubois terminates employment with the court or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, the
- 5 balance of the sick leave bank time shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank.
