### AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITIES LOAN FUND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 29 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 2000 the  
2 following section: — Section 2PPP. There is hereby established and set up on the books of the  
3 commonwealth a separate fund to be known as the Municipal Public Safety Facilities Loan  
4 Fund. There shall be credited to said fund such amounts as may appropriated or transferred by  
5 the general court. Monies credited to the fund shall, under the control of the secretary of public  
6 safety, to make no interest loans to cities and towns for the construction of public safety  
7 facilities. All loans should be repaid to the commonwealth not later than 20 years after any such  
8 loan is made. The method of repayment of such loans shall be through a deduction made on a  
9 recipient city or towns cherry sheet, so-called.
