### AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS FROM PAYING TOLLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 10 of chapter 81A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:— The authority shall not charge or collect a  
3 toll for transit over the turnpike and the different parts and sections thereof by private passenger vehicles  
4 registered to persons 70 years of age or older. The authority shall issue passes or stickers to carry out the  
5 provisions of this paragraph.

6           SECTION 2. Subsection (b) of section 10 of chapter 81A of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by  
7 adding the following paragraph:— The authority shall not charge or collect a toll for transit through the Callahan  
8 Tunnel, the Sumner Tunnel or the Ted Williams Tunnel by private passenger vehicles registered to persons 70  
9 years of age or older. The authority shall issue passes or stickers to carry out the provisions of this paragraph.
