AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING JUROR SERVICE FOR ELDERLY PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 4 of chapter 234A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "service", in line 9, the words:—; provided,
- 3 however, that upon receipt of such election no subsequent juror summons shall be sent to such
- 4 person, except upon the receipt of a written revocation of such election.
