**AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REMOVAL OF VETERANS COMMEMORATIVE FLAG HOLDERS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Section 75 of chapter 272 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 1, the word "flags".

3                   SECTION 2. Said section 75 of said chapter 272, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by adding the following  
4 paragraph:— No person shall remove an American Flag or Commemorative Flag Holder (or so-called medallions),  
5 commemorative flag holders representing service in the fire and police department, from any grave, tomb,  
6 monument or burial lot in any cemetery or other place of burial. A violation of this paragraph shall be punished by  
7 a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months.
