AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REMOVAL OF VETERANS, POLICE AND FIRE,
COMMEMORATIVE FLAG HOLDERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 73 of chapter 272 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby
2 amended by striking out, in lines 2 and 3, the words “veteran’s grave marker or metal plaque or flag” and inserting
3 in place thereof the following words: — American flag, veteran’s grave marker, metal plaque, veteran’s
4 commemorative flag holder, commemorative flag holder representing service in both the police and fire
5 department.
