AN ACT REQUIRING SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO ADOPT A CERTAIN HEALTH PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after Section 54B the following
- 2 section:— Section 54C. Each school district shall develop a program to identify and serve pupils with
- 3 light-based reading difficulties, best defined, as of December 1, 2002 by screening practices and
- 4 methodologies used to address Irlen syndrome and/or scotopic sensitivity, so called.
