AN ACT TO FURTHER DEFINE UNFAIR AND DECEPTIVE ACTS AND PRACTICES IN THE  
BUSINESS OF INSURANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION1. Section 3 of Chapter 176D, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by adding after subsection (12), the following subsection :-

3                   (13) Inaccurate premium quotations: Providing premium quotations, in any manner,  
4 including, but not limited to, in writing, verbally or electronically, which do not provide an  
5 accurate premium for the risk being quoted. When quoting private passenger automobile  
6 insurance, the quote must reflect surcharges for convictions of moving violations and at-fault  
7 accidents as maintained by the Massachusetts Merit Rating Board and/or other state's Divisions  
8 of Motor Vehicles.
