### AN ACT REGULATING UNIFORMED PRIVATE SECURITY FIRMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the  
2 contrary, any uniformed watch, guard or patrol employee licensed under Massachusetts General  
3 Law Chapter 147 Section 25, shall comply with any ordinance or town by-law or rules,  
4 regulations or licensing promulgated by the chief of police in any city or town with a population  
5 over 50,000 people.
