AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 44B of the General Laws as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition is hereby amended
- 2 by adding the following new section:-
- 3 Chapter 44B: Section 10 ½. Linkage Programs; Neighborhood Housing Trusts.
- 4 Section 10 ½. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 53 of chapter 44 of the General
- 5 Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, a city or town which has adopted a
- 6 linkage program and has established a neighborhood housing trust under Chapter 371 of the Acts
- of 1987 shall be eligible to receive monies from the community preservation trust fund
- 8 established under section 9 of chapter 44B of the General Laws.
- 9 (b) The commissioner of revenue shall disburse money into a city's neighborhood housing trust
- according to the provisions of section 10 of chapter 44B. The amount of money to be disbursed
- shall be equal to the amount collected by a city in affordable housing exactions under chapter
- 12 371 of the acts of 1987.
- 13 (c) Any monies transferred from the community preservation trust fund to the neighborhood
- 14 housing trust shall be used to encourage and facilitate the construction and preservation of
- affordable housing pursuant to the rules and regulations adopted by the neighborhood housing
- 16 trust.
