AN ACT TO IMPROVE ASTHMA MANAGEMENT .

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Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 32A of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 17I 2 the following section:-3 Section 17J.
