### AN ACT RELATIVE TO DISABLED VETERAN AND HANDICAPPED PARKING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1                   SECTION 1. Section 22 of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following paragraph:---
- 3 No penalty shall be imposed upon any disabled veteran or handicapped person who receives a citation for failing  
4 to display the special parking identification plate authorized by section two of chapter ninety or bears the official  
5 identification of a handicapped person issued by any other state, or any Canadian Province, so long as said  
6 disabled veteran or handicapped person displays official identification upon appeal of his or her parking violation.
