## AN ACT RELATIVE TO RECORDS OPEN TO PUBLIC INSPECTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 7 of Chapter 66 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:-
- 3            “All records in the custody of the state secretary which are ninety years or older shall be open to
- 4 public inspection.”
