### AN ACT RELATIVE TO STATE EMPLOYMENT POSTINGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 30 of Chapter 7 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended in line 7, by inserting after the first paragraph the following paragraph:-

4 “Every agency and institution of the Commonwealth shall transmit to the human resources division all  
5 employment opportunities, notices, and postings, excluding positions subject to section 46D of chapter  
6 30, chapter 31 and chapter 150E, including but not limited to notices of job opportunities, new positions  
7 and vacancies. The division shall immediately place all such information in the statewide employment  
8 computerized referral system. No position shall be filled without full compliance with this section”.
