**AN ACT RELATIVE TO TEACHER CERTIFICATION IN CARDIOPULMONARY
RESUSCITATION**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
2 inserting after Section 54B the following section: -

4 Section 54C -- All elementary and secondary schoolteachers in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
5 shall be required to be certified in the administration of cardiopulmonary resuscitation, as evidenced by
6 the successful completion of a training course in cardiopulmonary resuscitation from the American Red
7 Cross, American Heart Association or other agency approved by the Department of Public Health.
