## AN ACT RELATIVE TO ELECTRIC STREET POLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 34B of Chapter 164 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2002 official edition is
- 2 hereby amended by adding after the word 'pole;' in line 5 the following:-
- 3 "Provided further, that a city or town may enforce this section by the enactment of a local ordinance or
- 4 bylaw prohibiting double poles beyond the ninety days authorized by this section, violation of which may
- 5 be punishable by a fine not to exceed a maximum of \$100 per occurrence per day."
