**AN ACT TO PLACE CERTAIN JOB TITLES IN THE DIVISION OF STATE PARKS AND
RECREATION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION AND RECREATION UNDER THE
CIVIL SERVICE SYSTEM.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 Section1.

3 The following positions in the Division of State Parks and Recreation in the Department of
4 Conservation and Recreation shall be made permanent positions and placed under Chapter 31 of the
5 Massachusetts General Laws: Recreational Facility Supervisor 1, 2, 3, and 4; Recreational Facility
6 Repairer; Supervisor Rink and Pool; Forest and Park Regional Coordinator; and Laborer 1.

7 Incumbents who have served in the above-cited positions for two years or more and whose
8 positions are allocated to the official service, shall be subjected to a qualifying examination, and if
9 he/she passes, shall be deemed a tenured employee without serving any probationary period.

10 An incumbent in a position allocated to the labor service employed for two years or more shall
11 be deemed to be a tenured employee without serving any probationary period.

12 An incumbent of a position allocated to the official service, who has been employed less than
13 two years shall be subjected to a qualifying examination and if he/she passes, shall be deemed to be a
14 tenured employee after serving a probationary period.

15 An incumbent of a position allocated to the labor service who has been employed less than two
16 years shall be deemed a tenured employee after serving a probationary period.
