### **AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MASSACHUSETTS COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT SYSTEM TESTS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 69 of the General Laws or any general or specific law to the
- 2 contrary, achieving the Massachusetts comprehensive system tests competency determination for the tenth grade
- 3 shall not be a condition of graduation for any student enrolled in a special education program.
