AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TOWN OF PAXTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 7 of Chapter 44 of the general laws or
- 2 any other general or special law to the contrary, the Town of Paxton is authorized to incur debt
- 3 for the purpose of paying for costs incurred in the acquisition of property, designing, developing,
- 4 constructing and equipping a new Public Safety Complex, so called, to house the Town's Police
- 5 and Fire Departments, for a term not exceeding forty (40) years. Any debt incurred hereunder
- 6 shall otherwise be subject to the provisions of said Chapter 44.
